Curry opened a discussion about the village's income tax. Recently, over 700 letters were mailed to individuals who haven't filed their 2023 Village Income Tax return. This indicates that income potential tax revenue is missing. Curry mentioned that while our current tax program lacks in some areas, that is only a portion of the problem. Data matching resources aren't available or utilized so we heavily rely on residents reporting changes which, unfortunately, often doesn't happen. Curry asked for feedback and

opinions on RITA (Regional Income Tax Agency). RITA administers municipal income tax for about 50% of Ohio's cities and villages. Curry acknowledged the pros and cons of RITA. While the cost of RITA membership is significant, the increase in revenue to the village could offset that expense.

Shoemaker said he'd like to see the village's money stay local. Rather than paying RITA to administer our income tax, he'd like to increase our staff and keep administering our own income tax. He also has concerns about RITA's customer service.

Kellogg said that RITA's tax forms are complicated. She asked if RITA is better at finding people and collecting tax on those required to do so. At a tax seminar earlier this year, Curry learned that RITA has many resources for locating taxpayers and collecting taxes. But she has not researched the specific resources they utilize. Should the discussion on RITA continue, Curry will research this topic further.

Vaughn has heard a lot of negative feedback from communities that use RITA. He said he's heard that law enforcement has been involved in some communities where issues have arisen due to RITA.

Curry will continue to gather information and look at options and solutions to maximize the village's income tax compliance and revenue.
